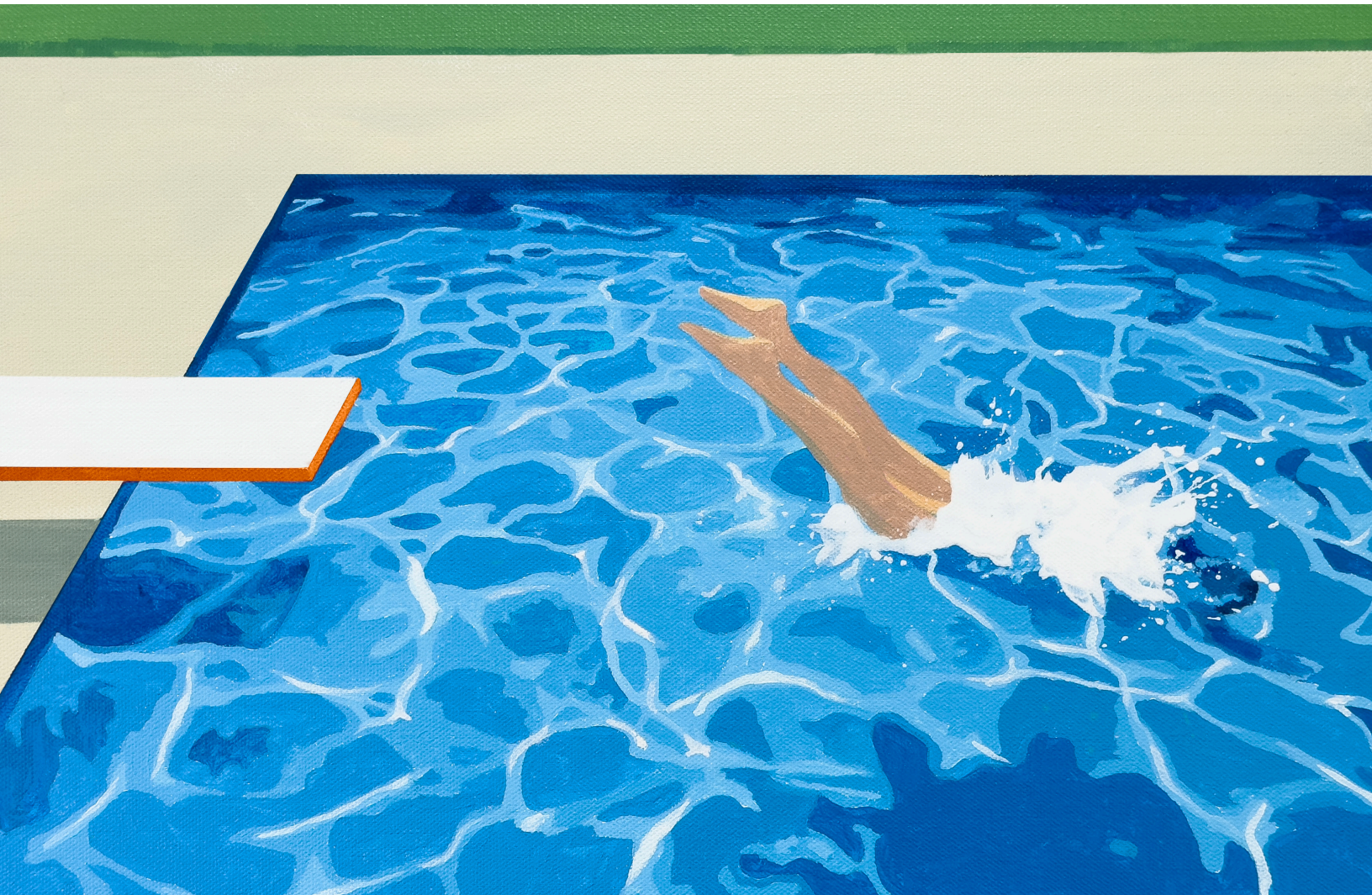

HFAF is deeply embedded into the cultural fabric of our historic community. We are produced by Hamptonites for Hamptonites.

- After **18 years**, attending is ingrained in the community as a much anticipated annual cultural event. The entire local art community unites around this event.
- The Pavilions are named after two prominent Hamptons based artists – **Pollock** and **de Kooning**
- Serves as a vital forum for both “rediscovery” of **Hamptons based 1950-70’s era artists**, as well as a new wave of **emerging talent**.
- Presenting the third annual **Hamptons Artists Hall of Fame** (2025 inductions).
- Virtually all of the area’s leading art museums, foundations, charities, and social clubs, are engaged. Prominent and influential collectors, affluent newbies, ASID interior designers, art advisors and museum curators regularly attend.
- Producer **Rick Friedman** (a well-known collector of AbEx works with museum shows), and team now on their 19th successful year of producing major cultural events in The Hamptons, including the pioneering **ArtHamptons**.

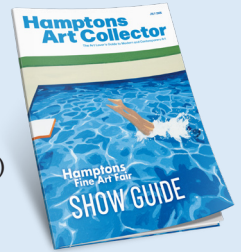
- Artwork prices should begin at the \$5,000 level, with a “sweet spot” of \$25,000. Many works will be in the 6 figures and into the 7 figures.
- Opportunities to qualify for special highlighted artist promotions with designations of **Featured Artists, Spotlight Artists, Solo Artist booths**, and displays devoted to specific country, or art genre.
- Artist selection **approval and curation**
- Discounted hotel room rates for exhibitors
- Opportunity to participate in a much discounted **Hamptons Art Collector/HFAF Show Guide** in an advertising/ editorial special section.
